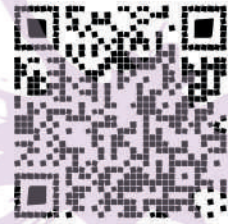
Who we are?

Cooperativa Margherita is a non-profit cooperative and social enterprise established in 1987 and located in Sandrigo.

Our mission is to work in synergy with the territory and inside the life contexts of people, so that each person is able to be the protagonist of his own existence and an active part of the community. We design and manage services and events promoting citizenship, inclusion, self-determination, participation, information and culture.

We address the whole citizenship and in particular people with disabilities, elderly people, children, and youngsters.

The start date of the activity: September 2019
The duration of the activity: long term 12 months
The application deadline: 30th June 2019

The project: "ROW - Rights of Whom?" foresees the involvement of the volunteers in different centres and activities of Margherita, which are:

CALEIDO: centre for people with disabilities as medium-heavy mental retardation, behavioural disorders, communication problems, pervasive growth disturbance, brain damages.

AGENZIA TERRITORIALE: centre for self-sufficient people with disabilities, but good relational-skills, able to maintain a working experience, with/without external support/supervision.

APOLLO, VOLO and after school services: centres for disadvantaged children reported by municipalities' social services. They host maximum 10-15 children in need of special protection and educational, relational and/or school support from 6 to 14 years-old.

The volunteers will have the opportunity to relate with disadvantaged people promoting Human Rights and social inclusion at the community level. moreover, they will be involved in further innovative projects developed by Margherita (as the EU project Mind Inclusion2.0) and the realization of local cultural activities and events.

In the centres for disabled people volunteers will collaborate in:

- Proposing and managing new laboratories while helping with current ones (recycled paper, music, etc.);
- Supporting the operators during workshops and monitoring users in house-hold tasks, i.e. table-setting, custom tasks: do the daily shopping, office commissions, etc.
- Coaching users in the acquisition and maintenance of defined skills (as computer skills, communication skills, etc.);

In the centres for children volunteers will collaborate in:

- Support in doing homework, studying and planning a study-method;
- Collaboration in the management of laboratories and planned activities: decorations, kitchen lab., curiosity&magazine lab., informatics lab., research on the territory;
- Active participation in team-meetings, planning and managing social integration activities;
- Participation in projects/experiences on the territory, elaborated by Margherita in partnership with municipalities, schools and/or other educational



Furthermore Volunteers will be involved in the promotion of social activities and the realization of media contents.

What every EVS volunteer should know before arriving in Sandrigo

Your accommodation

Volunteers are hosted in a shared apartment located in Sandrigo (VI), close to Margherita headquarters, where they live together in shared rooms. The selected apartment is provided with 1 kitchen, 1 dining/living-room, 2 bathrooms, 3 shared bedrooms, 1 lumber-room, 2 terraces, 1 garage. The flat is furnished and have free Wi-Fi connection.

Public transport

Sandrigo is connected through bus services to the two main cities of the region, Vicenza and Bassano del Grappa. Given that Sandrigo is in a country side area each volunteers will be recognized a an amount of 80,00 euros to spend for journeys during leisure time.

Working hours

30-38 h/week approximately.

Food-money and pocket money

Lunch are provided at Margherita' Canteens. Furthermore, volunteers will receive each month a food allowance and a pocket money.

Holidays

2 days per month plus national public holidays.

The ways to come to us

By plane: closest airports are Venice Marco Polo, Verona Catullo and Treviso San't Angelo.

By Train: the train station is in Vicenza.

Airport and train stations are connected through public transport system to Sandrigo. One two way travel is reimbursed (or arranged) by the project up to 275€.

Insurance

Volunteers are covered by a group insurance plan specifically designed to protect them during their period of voluntary activity. The cover is free of charge for the volunteers. All volunteers should ask for the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) in their own country befor travelling.

Language training course

Online Linguistic Support is provided by the EU commission. Furthermore, volunteers will enjoy a direct course provided by the provincial centre for adults education or other local partners.

Living in Sandrigo

Sandrigo is a small town of the province of Vicenza located in a country side area. Anyway it offers cultural and sports entertainment: cinema, public places, swimming pools and sport facilities. Margherita will support in connecting the volunteers to local associations or leisure opportunities according to availability and their interest.
